



## **Track-and-trace information flow**

**From Seed** 

Record trim, waste, and harvests; combine plant material into packages

Manufacture products and packages; record inputs, yields, and waste.

Record final sale information, including price; integrate with other agency systems













Tag viable plants or group of plants with a unique identifier

Create detailed transport manifests and transfer packages to another business

Test products for pesticides, microbials, potency, etc. and results are recorded







## **Tagged inventory**


- There are two types of tagged inventory in Metrc: plants and packages.
- Plants are immature, vegetative, or flowering. All plants must enter the system through immature plant batches. However, immature plants will be entered as un-tagged Planting Groups in Metrc.
- Packages are created from immature plants, harvest batches or other packages.





## **Plant tracking**


The plants inventory grids offer detailed information for each uniquely serialized plant across all growth phases.





## Harvest tracking

In the Harvest grid, all granular information and associated historical data is captured.






## Package tracking






